DID YOU KNOW?

There is a State Statute addressing the opportunity for DMV customers to indicate their donation status? When a customer says "no" to registering as a donor, they receive information where they can find resources and potentially register at a later time at Life-Source.org.

When a customer says "yes" to checking the box they will receive a "registered donor" sticker. When a customer says "no" they will recieve a donor document card.

There are more than 100,000 people – over 3,000 people locally – waiting for a lifesaving organ transplant.

60% of people waiting for a lifesaving transplant are people of color.

Another person is added to the nation's waiting list every 9 minutes.

17 people die each day while waiting for a transplant.
