

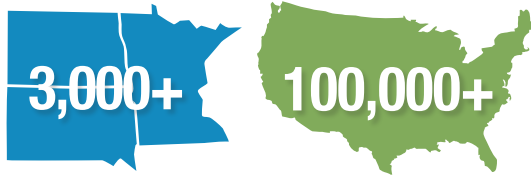

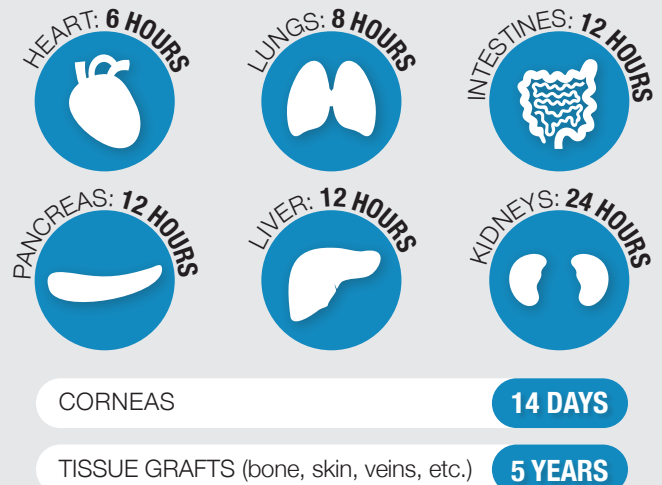
Each day, **17 people** die while waiting for a transplant. A new name is added to the transplant waiting list every **9 minutes**.

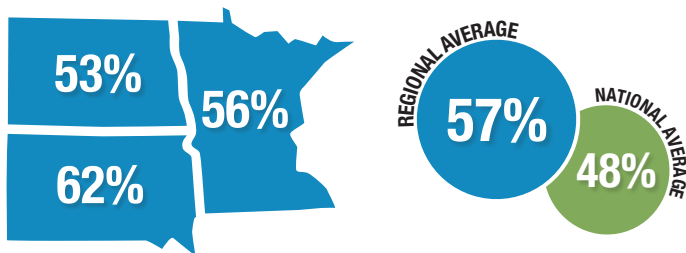

Transplants must occur within specific time frames:



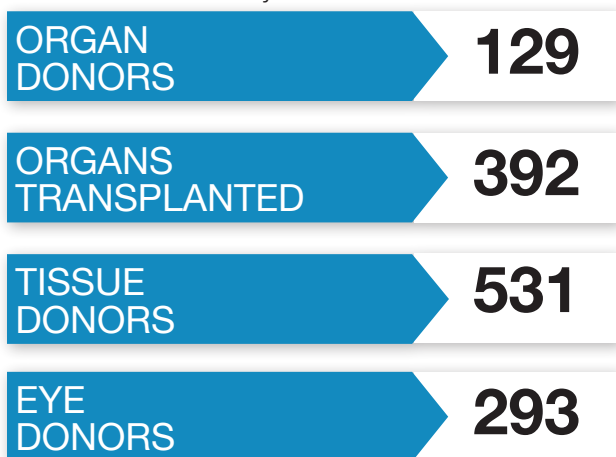
ADULTS REGISTERED AS DONORS
